ADVANTAGES OF PANEL MOULDED DOORS

- Panel moulded doors have a wonderful aesthetic appeal. Apart from the design the door facings are also textured. These can further be polished or painted.
- Panel moulded doors have a high density - 3.0 mm thick densified wood fibre (DWF) plates, compared to core veneer of 2.4 mm and face veneer of 0.4 mm used in flush doors. This gives them unmatched durability.
- The density of a DWF plate is around 900 kg/m³ compared to 550 kg/m³ of veneer wood which doubles the strength.
- Glue Line Internal Protection (GLP) makes our panel moulded doors are resistant to termites and borers.
- Panel moulded doors are made of the best raw materials which are a result of extensive R & D, and are designed to give superior performance.
- Panel moulded doors are primered before shipping and are easier to paint and polish.
- Panel moulded doors have the green advantage as they consume less wood and help conserve forests.

HOW TO HANDLE

- Check doors for defects and damage immediately upon receipt.

- Doors must be kept in a dry place.

- Polythene wrapping should be retained till the time of fixing the door.

- To minimise the risk of distortion, doors must be stored flat on three, level bearers.

- Care must be taken while lifting the door as it may be heavy.

- The door must not be exposed to water for a very long time as it is made of wood and timber-like contents, which may lead to minor discolouration and distortion.

- After hanging in freshly plastered rooms, the door should be left half open at all times to allow air to circulate around it until the house dries out. The door must not be fully opened, to ensure that the face of the door is away from the freshly plastered wall.

- Once distorted, the door will not perfectly revert when it dries.

- Do not hang the door immediately after plastering.

- To help seal the door and further reduce the chances of distortion, the entire surface should be painted. The bottom of the door must be painted before hanging.

- Hinges must be aligned to prevent bending.

- The door must be installed square, true and plumb and it must be hung in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions or the architect's specifications.

- In the event where the door width needs to be trimmed to fit, equal measure must be removed from each long edge. If the door needs to be trimmed for length, equal measure must be removed from the top and bottom. (Max 12 mm from each side)
